

Outlook Skating Club Safety Protocols

Be ice ready

- Waivers must be signed for the season prior to first day of lessons
- Please review daily screening questions before coming to the rink.
- All skaters should arrive to the rink no more than 10 mins prior to session.
- Late skaters may not be allowed to enter sessions at this time. Facility doors may be locked during sessions.
- Skaters should be dressed and ready.
- SKATERS NEED TO COME WITH SKATES ON IF THEY CANNOT TIE THEIR OWN SKATES.
- Skaters need to label skate guards and water bottles.
- Skaters are asked to bring minimal items and small or no bags would be preferred.
- STAR skaters can bring a small bag with personal items onto the ice with them and it will be placed in designated areas. Wallets, phones, keys and water bottles.
- We will not be using change rooms at this time.
- Water fountains will be closed so please fill water bottles before getting to the rink.

Entering Building

- Skaters will enter in main doors
- Masks are recommended but not required at this time.
- Check in at front desk
 - Verbal screening and sanitize hands
 - Attendance (including adult with skater) will be taken for every session to allow for contact tracing if needed.
 - Emergency contact for skater for current session (cell number) is to be given when signing skater in. We will keep records for every member however a number must be given each time for the person in charge of drop off and pick up that day.
 - Parents/spectators are not allowed in the facility at this time. Protocols may change throughout season.
 - We will have a volunteer at the sign in desk who will also be in the facility during the sessions if skaters need anything or there is an emergency.
 - There will be a schedule made for volunteers as we cannot run without them.
- Masks are not required of skaters at this time. Coaches and Assistants will be wearing masks for CanSkate.
- Skaters will line up spaced and will follow supervisor to the ice surface. We will be entering the ice through the gate closet to the lobby.
- Coaches/Assistants/Supervisors are the only people allowed to touch doors and allow skaters on and off the ice.
- Coaches/Assistants/Supervisors will wipe down areas needed between groups.

Exiting Ice

- Skaters will leave the ice at a different gate to allow the next group to come on without interaction.
- Skaters will then move to chairs/benches to remove skates and will leave through the designated exit doors.

** We will have an adult supervisor in the lobby however we strongly recommend that you make sure your child has gone to the washroom prior to getting to the rink and on the ice.

** Supervisor and coaches have the right to refuse skaters if they display any signs or symptoms of Covid-19. Please make sure you screen your child prior to coming to the rink.

** Program and facility rules and procedures may change over the course of the season. We will communicate all changes as they are announced to us.

Please understand that the coaches are directed to not have any contact with the skaters and will not be allowed to hold hands, help skaters up, fix toques, mitts and wipe noses. It will be a different year for all of us, but we are still very excited to be back on the ice with you all!
